

ST. ALBANS ARCHITECTURAL SCAVENGER HUNT

Long known as "Railroad City", Saint Albans, Vermont was initially incorporated as a village in 1859, then as a city in 1902. The compact downtown has many historical buildings that have helped shape this city's history.
